We have audited the accompanying balance sheet of the World Rainforest Movement Foundation-WRM, as at 31 December 2016, and the related statements of income and cash flows, explanatory notes, annexes and other information for the year then ended.

The management of the World Rainforest Movement Foundation-WRM is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements, annexes and explanatory notes. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with: a) the International Standards on Auditing issued by the International Federation of Accountants (IFAC), b) the statements of the College of Accountants, Economists and Administrators of Uruguay. The College of Accountants and Economist of Uruguay, is an association of professionals in the field of economics and a member of IFAC, has issued technical statements regarding the International Financial Reporting Standards and International Standards on Auditing required of its members in the provision of their services, c) the guidelines received from foreign funding agencies.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements.
